SPRING MUSTER

SUNDAY, APRIL 22ND, 1:00 PM

WHERE: Our First Annual Spring Muster, Drill, and School of Instruction will be held at the CEDARCROFT FARM Bed & Breakfast, Warrensburg (Bill's house), located Southeast of Warrensburg. From Warrensburg, take Mo 13 south to Y, East on Y 4.0 miles to driveway. From Sedalia, take US 50 west to Rt D, D south to Y, west on Y 6.3 miles. From Windsor, take WW north to D, D north to Y, west on Y 6.3 miles. From Clinton, take Mo 13 north to Y, then east 4.0 miles.

WHEN: Come as early as 10:00 AM for a picnic lunch (bring a covered dish) at 11:30. Drill starts promptly at 1:00 PM.

DRESS: Wear your uniform if you have one; if you don't, wear whatever you have that you hope will pass. Veterans bring extra uniform parts so we can check sizes & fits on our recruits.

WEAPONS: Plan to drill with your 3-band if you have one; if you have a Hawken, a shotgun, or revolver, bring it (them) for authenticity and safety check. Also, bring any edged weapons you'd like to carry.

SCHEDULE: Drill will not be continuous - expect reasonable breaks.

Drill will be conducted rain or shine - plenty of room

the barn.

10:00 AM to 11:30: arrive, look around, have gear checked, talk about what's needed & potential sources.

11:30 - 12:30: picnic lunch.

1:00 PM: Manual of arms instruction.

2:00 PM: Drill & facing instruction, w/o arms.

3:00 PM: Drill under arms.

4:00 PM: Firing practice.

5:00 PM: Camp closes, consumption of beverages in non-authentic containers OK.

REFERENCES: Recruits should have received a drill primer & manual of arms primer. Read them - you'll still be confused, but you won't be able to claim absolute total ignorance.
