**FUNDRAISING:** Total donations received for the revolvers was \$2971; with the \$2000 added money, less expenses, both we and the SCV ended with \$2000. We greatly appreciate our friends of the J.O. Shelby Camp, SCV, without whose efforts (& tax exempt status) this fundraiser would not have been successful. Suggested follow-on efforts include chances on a gift certificate from Cedarcroft at the Warrensburg Fall Festival, working a concession booth at a Chiefs game, & a Brat Sale the first weekend in November.

We need to plan what we're going to do. Top priorities are 3 full uniforms (1 more musket, 2 sets leathers, a shell, 3 pair pants - about \$850). We need more canvass (\$200). Everything else is open to your suggestions.

## ***AFTER ACTION REPORT - LONE JACK:***

Capt Koffman: I had the honor to command a contingent of 17 of our men at Lone Jack on the 15th & 16th inst. Since all the corporals had accompanied you to the East, I appointed Pvt Kisner as Acting Corporal. We were augmented by a few men from Crowley's Company, plus one each from the 9th Texas & 8th Missouri; Landis' Battery provided 2 guns & the 2nd Mo Cav furnished Cavalry cover while the ACWMA tended the wounded. Federal troops were commanded by a Dutchman named Kesinger.

Since the numbers were so few on either side, we fought from skirmish order. The Federals had particularly poor aim while our artillery was exceptionally accurate, so the first day's action ended in their virtual annihilation. On the second day, both sides had received reinforcements & the enemy's marksmanship had improved considerably, but the artillery again proved to be decisive as we again swept the field, victorious.

I commend to your attention Sgt Riggs, who ably filled in the 1st Sgt position, as well as Acting Corp Kisner & Veterans Siefkas, Tucker, Block, Daleen & Powell, who ably steadied the line. Recruits Gilger, Harms & Niner held up in their first taste of action. Privates Baker, Morris, Massey, Jackson, Root & Swigart also helped repel the foe.

### **THE WEDDING:**

Gaylen & Charlene's wedding went very well, with a nice representation from many units. We ended up with 8 sabers on the Honor Guard. Ask Gaylen about his 'bachelor party.' Jeff sends his thanks to all those who helped.

### **TID-BITS:**

*Pvt Tucker* avoided execution almost the entire season, but so enraged the Lt by suggesting the Lt pay for lunch, that he was summarily placed in front of a dozen muskets & dispatched. He made a fine corpse, resurrecting only when the civilians started to strip the body.

We collected a number of conscripts on one of our marches through the display area; despite their lack of proper uniforms, they quickly picked up how to face right, march, & march By Company Into Line. One who refused to be conscripted will, I am sure, receive the jibes of his friends for some time.

We provided honors at the ceremony & wreath-laying after the battle, forming a single company of both Federals & Confederates. The 3 volleys fired were crisp & impressive. Ike Skelton, who gave the main speech (this being an election year), heard our prowess.

**MCWRA ELECTIONS:** There are 5 nominees for President Elect ('94 President) and 10 for three Board positions. If you are wondering whom to vote for, wait until the group has a chance to talk over our knowledge of the candidates. I recommend voting for people who can contribute rather than those looking for an ego trip. Unit leaders already have a voice, as well. There's a brief discussion inside. You can hand-deliver your ballot at any of our September activities.

## GLASGOW TID-BITS:

My compliments to the men for their expertise in executing the evolutions of military drill, especially those complex maneuvers done from the inverted. Out of deference to the Captain, I will not state how we became inverted, but when he discovered the situation, the following conversation ensued:

- *Capt. Koffman*. "U-oh. We're inverted. How do we get out of this?"
- *Pvt Dressel*. "Try On the Left By Files into Line"
- *Capt Koffman* (looking at Lt Wayne): "Can they do that???"
- *Corp Lee*: "Damn right we can do it, let's go!"

## ***EVENT DETAILS***

**WARRENSBURG FALL FESTIVAL:** September 12 (Saturday). Meet at corner of Holden & Culton (Public Library) by 11:30. We're scheduled for our precision drill demo between noon and 1. We'll have a tent set up so we can do some recruiting, as well. Video party at Charlie's afterwards!

**KEYTESVILLE:** September 19 (Saturday). Parade at 2:00 PM, followed by honors at the statue. Festivities last from 9 to 5. We can set up a tent, do periodic drills, recruit like hell. To get there, US 65 to Marshall, MO 41 north across Missouri River to US 24, US 24 east 20 miles to Keytesville (or US 63 to Moberly, US 24 west to Keytesville). Once you get there, ask.

**PILOT KNOB, MO,** September 25-26. I registered 20-25 men/5 ladies. Impression is our 'Price's Raid' (see your Uniform/Equipment guide). 3-band Enfields preferred, but other documentable weapons (mil or civilian) OK. To get there (scenic) US 50 to Jeff City, US 63 to Vichy, MO 68 to St. James, MO 8 to Potosi, MO 21 to Pilot Knob (235 mi). Via 4-lane: I-70 to St Louis, I-44 to Festus, US 67 to Farmington, W & V to Pilot Knob (300 mi).

**PERRYVILLE, KY,** October 9-11. I registered 33 positions, which is well over our commitment; anyone who hasn't paid, do so next time you see me. vation assn, needed by August 1st. Max camp authenticity required. Military weapons only (no Zouaves). Military impression is our generic Confederate. Civilian impression must be functioning! Battalion Max effort. They asked that we double up in tents & not bring wall tents; company streets, if available, will be cramped. Traffic will be one-way out on back gravel roads on Sunday; you'll be unable to leave the area until the event is over once you get situated. We'll need to bring our own food rations & anyone going will be expected to contribute. To get there: I-70 to St Louis, I-64 to Louisville, I-65 so to exit 112, KY 245 to Bardstown, US 150 e to Perryville [71 mi from Louisville]. (550 mi approx total).

**CABIN CREEK, OK,** Oct 17-18. Two attacks on federal supply trains at critical creek crossing, including some wagon burning. Don't have detailed info yet, but appears there will be a lot of other things going on, as well. From Carthage: I-44 west to Big Cabin exit (US 69), US 69 south to Adair, OK 28 east.

**WARSAW HERITAGE DAYS,** Oct 24-25. Set up near Hooper House near visitor center, do periodic drills & recruit.

**PRAIRIE GROVE, AR,** Dec 5-6. 130th Anniversary of Gen Hindman's attempt to whip 2 small armies under Blunt & Herron, at the same time. Original battlefield (Ark state park), Generic CS impression best, overcoats may be helpful. To get there, US 71 so to Fayetteville, US 62 west to Prairie Grove.


